Geri-Fit® Requirements



- Offer classes at a senior center, church, retirement community, yoga studio, hospital, country club, or other approved facility that has an open area with 20 to 30 sturdy banquet style chairs
- License fee: \$950 one time only, then a \$150 annual renewal fee
- Professional Liability Insurance and a Certificate of Insurance naming Geri-Fit Company LLC as an Additional Insured
- Instructor must be certified in CPR (additional certifications may be required by the facilities where classes are offered)
- Instructor must have a computer and internet access and complete the online training and certification program (20-40 hours depending on familiarity with strength training exercises performed with dumbbells),
- All Licensed instructors are required to complete an 80 question online
 Written Examination in order to receive their Certificate of Completion.
